During the first few weeks we spend our time getting to know our new friends and learning the rules and routines of the classroom. The staff also complete "Baseline Assessments" to determine where each children's skills and knowledge fit within the EYFS Curriculum. The children get to know each other better when sharing their baby pictures, family pictures and their own happy box.

The children will also spend lots of time, hearing, acting out and retelling nursery rhymes as the beginning of our Literacy work.
